



Summary

Between 11 October and 8 November 2022 Central Coast Council sought community feedback on the concept plans for accessibility improvements to Niagara Park Stadium.

Central Coast Council received \$850,000 from Round Four of the Stronger Country Community Fund to improve accessibility to the Niagara Park Stadium.

The project proposes to provide an accessibility upgrade, including a new driveway, car park including two disabled parking spaces and pedestrian pathways as well as a refresh to the building's façade, to support current community use and encourage patronage to the area.

The community were invited to have their say on the following accessibility updates and aesthetic improvements:

- New driveway and car park
- New pedestrian pathways
- Updated building façade

Council wanted to hear about how these improvements can be made with both local and visiting communities' needs in mind.

Engagement Results

A total of 11 comments were received and a total of 71 votes were placed on comments and features. The concept plans received 89% support for the proposed features.

Themes from the feedback included:

- Improving access via new pathways
- · Additional disabled parking spaces
- Façade and protecting future vandalism
- Bike racks and bush regeneration
